

Also Red and Spice


**Also Gold and Mustard**

#### Red and Blue Combo


Note that they are generally more desaturated than Althletic Reds and Blues.

Lemon, Ten Orange, Lime








## **Geometric Update**

## Floral Update

I'd call the current trend "Tiki Ennui": understated flowers, muted colors, 50s references, subdued tropical motifs, as though Bill Murray were the star of an Elvis beach movie.









Other trends we've been seeing like antiqued florals and geometric florals are still around but waning.







## **RMC Update**

Still going strong in the mass market.





BWR (Black, White, Red) continues to maintain a prescence as well.



### **Trend: Warm Flesh Tones**

I imagine this is still part of the shock waves from Rose Quartz.



This trend probably doesn't effect our products as much, other than a possible inclusion of more Spice.

Also, some of these tones could be responding to the Victorian trend that blew through this Winter.



## **Trend: Thin Colorful Stripes**

This picks up on the muted color palette, 90s trends (especially Red and Blue mixed together), and possible inclusion of South American and West Indian influence.





There is a certain ornry quality to it, loud and obtusely/aggressively youthful.



## **Trend: Bright and Bold**

Although the colors are loud and multilayered, the shapesare simplified and urban.

Possible keywords: comics, 90s, EDM, youth, early video games Possible roots responding to trends originally influenced by 1980's NYC artists.
